# On-Premise

With this option, you can purchase and install Inception on existing computing infrastructure in your facility. Your engineering and IT teams will be responsible to manage the infrastructure and the software.

Does your company manage or have access to a private cloud environment?

#### **Private Cloud**

This means your company has access to centralized infrastructure that is likely located in a different location than your broadcast facility. Local staff will likely not take responsibility for infrastructure, but may still be responsible for managing the software.

# **Public Cloud**

With a public cloud option, you can lease cloud computing resources provided by companies such as Amazon, Google and Microsoft. You can then purchase Inception and host it in the public cloud using those resources. You are responsible for configuring the cloud resources and maintaining the software.

# Software as a Service (SaaS)

SaaS refers to cloud computing resources and software that are managed by Ross Video on your behalf. With this option, you can subscribe to the Inception.cloud service and Ross will deploy and maintain it for you.











For content creators using Inception, the functionality is the same across traditional on-premise solutions, cloud deployments and SaaS.

The decision comes down to the desired level of control and responsibility for the application and infrastructure, as well as the preferred financial commitment.
